#### Accepted format

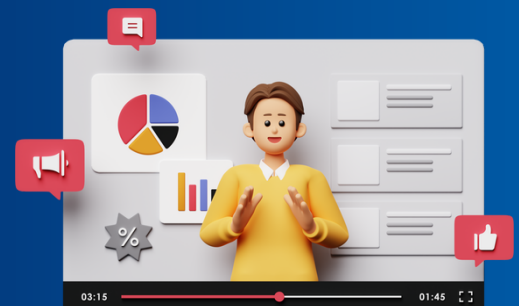
- Abstract should be submitted in English
- Word document format
- Arial font and font size 10
- Maximum 500-word count limit (excluding references/figures/tables)
- Use a concise title

#### Authoring

- Enlist all authors and affiliation authors
- Highlight the presenting author
- Type of presentation (paper / poster presentation)

#### Abstract content

- Single-spaced, typed in lower case and contain:
  - Introduction
  - Methods
  - Results
  - Conclusion
